



# NOTICE OF GROUND INVESTIGATION SURVEYS

## What are we doing?

As we develop the design of the HS2 high-speed railway, we are undertaking ground investigation surveys in your area. Our contractor will be carrying out ground investigation surveys.

Ground investigation is the examination and study of the soil, rocks and groundwater below the surface.

These surveys help us to understand the ground conditions near the planned route of the railway, so that any future construction is safe and efficient.

## How will this affect me?

From 29 August 2017, our contractor will be undertaking ground investigation surveys on Stoneleigh Park, Kenilworth.

The Surveys will be carried out in accordance with the terms of the Access License and HS2 Ltd.'s Contractor's programme.

When the work is complete, our contractor will restore the area to its previous condition.

## Duration of works

- Weekday working hours: 08:00 am to 10:00 am
- Saturday working hours: no weekend working
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown.

## What to expect

- Background noise from the drilling of boreholes, windowless sampling and the use of water pumps.
- Contractor vehicle movements to and from the site(s).

## What we will do

- Inform you in advance of any changes to the dates shown.
- Keep all sites safe and secure.
- Ensure that the contractor vehicles use agreed routes.
- Ensure that all sites are reinstated to the required standard.
